Greetings band members! I hope you have had a great summer. Here are the details for camp. Rookie and Percussion Camp is July 18-22. Full Band Camp is July 25-29. If you have a job, coordinate with your employer to be off work for camp.

BAND FEES

Band fees are \$60 and should ideally be paid first thing Monday morning of Full Band Camp. If your family has more than one child in the high school band (not beginner or jr. high band), the fee for the first child is \$60 and \$40 for the second. Color guard fees are an additional \$40. Guard shoes, should you need new ones, will be an additional \$44. Checks may be made payable to the *Eupora Band Boosters*.

PERCUSSION CAMP

All percussionist will rehearse July 18-22 from 1:30 pm to 5:00 pm. This is both battery and pit.

ROOKIE CAMP

Rookie Camp for all 1st year members is July 18-22 from 8:00 am to 12:00 am. Who goes to Rookie camp? Anyone who is marching their first year in the high school band.

FULL BAND CAMP

Full Band Camp will run July 25 through July 29 from 8:00 am to 11:30 am and from 1:00 pm to 5:30 pm. I will stay at the band hall during lunch. So, you do not have to leave if you do not have a ride...you just can't eat *my* food.

WHAT TO BRING

- Thermos Bottle
- Pencil

- Tennis Shoes (No Flip Flops)
- Hat, Sunglasses, Sunscreen
- Cash for reeds, valve oil, etc.

Tennis shoes and socks are required footwear for everyone at band camp. Appropriate dress must be observed at all times. Sorry ladies, "Short-shorts" and free flowing sleeveless shirts over sports brass are not acceptable.

ROOKIE EXPENSES

Below is a complete list of the necessary expenses for first year marchers. A flip folder is used to store stands music and comes with 16 windows, which will hold 32 pieces of music. A lyre is a device for securing the flip folder to the instrument and varies in price according to the instrument. The flute lyre has a flip folder attached to it. Students who already have one may use their own lyre. The prices below are accurate for *most* of the lyres we sell. Specialty lyres cost extra.

You are expected to attend all home and away football games, including post-season play. On occasion, due to weather or safety, we may decide not to travel to an away game, but that is very rare. Also, if we have a playoff game the day after Thanksgiving, we will use a volunteer pep band. In addition to the Eupora Christmas parade, you are also required to attend the following marching contests:
